## Priority options for action - discussion

For the high priority option for action that your table has been allocated to discuss (30 minutes):

- Identify tangible/feasible/practical actions to implement this high priority option for action – *Record these onto butchers paper*
- Who needs to be involved (NAMES of individuals and organisations) to make this happen? – *record onto the butchers paper*
- Identify the **three key actions** to report back to the whole group
